The Lordship of Jesus

In Acts 2, Jesus fulfills his promise to the apostles that they would receive the Holy Spirit. Almost immediately, they began to fulfill the great commission and became His witnesses in Jerusalem. Peter begins to proclaim the good news of Jesus and says,

"Men of Israel, hear these words: Jesus of Nazareth, a man attested to you by God with mighty works and wonders and signs that God did through him in your midst, as you yourselves know—this Jesus, delivered up according to the definite plan and foreknowledge of God, you crucified and killed by the hands of lawless men. God raised him up, loosing the pangs of death, because it was not possible for him to be held by it" (Acts 2:22-24).

In verses 32-36, Peter continues,

"This Jesus God raised up, and of that we all are witnesses. Being therefore exalted at the right hand of God, and having received from the Father the promise of the Holy Spirit, he has poured out this that you yourselves are seeing and hearing. For David did not ascend into the heavens, but he himself says, "'The Lord said to my Lord, "Sit at my right hand, until I make your enemies your footstool." Let all the house of Israel therefore know for certain that God has made him both Lord and Christ, this Jesus whom you crucified."

Peter makes it clear that Jesus the Christ is Lord! The words of the Spirit spoken through Peter cut the listeners to the heart. They were convicted, they believed in Jesus as the Messiah, and they wanted to know how to make Jesus Lord of their lives. Peter told them to,

"Repent and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins, and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. For the promise is for you and for your children and for all who are far off, everyone whom the Lord our God calls to himself" (Acts 2:38,39), and verse 41 tells us they responded to the truth by submitting to Jesus as Lord of their lives, "So those who received his word were baptized, and there were added that day about three thousand souls."

What does the Lordship of Jesus mean practically? It means we recognize Him for who He is; the Son of God; the King of kings and Lord of lords. As Lord, Jesus deserves our honor, reverence, and obedience. He is the source of salvation to all who obey Him (Heb. 5:9). If Jesus is my Lord, then I can say with Paul, "I have been crucified with Christ. It is no longer I who live, but Christ who lives in me. And the life I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me" (Galatians 2:20). Walk by faith and not by sight and show the world that Jesus is Lord!
