Which Voice Are You Listening To?

Last Sunday night we went through Genesis 3 during the sermon. The point of the lesson was this; we make the wrong choices when we listen to the wrong voices. Adam and Eve had listened to God's voice and instruction about not eating from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil (Gen. 2:16,17). God said, "Don't eat it!" In Genesis 3, they listen to another voice, the serpent. The serpent twists God's words to make it sound like God is withholding goodness from His creation, and the serpent tells them, if you eat from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, God knows you will be like Him. Adam and Eve choose to ignore God's voice of truth and goodness. They also choose not only to listen to the serpent, but they gave thought to his words, and then acted against God.

Here are 3 dangerous voices that we tend to listen to.

- Deceptive voices like the serpent. "You will not surely die. For God knows that when you eat of it your eyes will be opened, and you will be like God, knowing good and evil" (Gen. 3:4,5).
- Our own voice. "There's a way that seems right to a man, but its end is the way of death" (Prov. 14:12).
- Those who tell us what we want to hear. "For the time is coming when people will not endure sound teaching, but having itching ears they will accumulate for themselves teachers to suit their own passions, and will turn away from listening to the truth and wander off into myths" (2 Tim. 4:3,4).

We need to listen to Jesus.

- "Everyone then who hears these words of mine and does them will be like a wise man who built his house on the rock. And the rain fell, and the floods came, and the winds blew and beat on that house, but it did not fall, because it had been founded on the rock" (Matt. 7:24,25).
- "This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased; listen to him" (Matt. 17:5).
- "My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me. I give them eternal life, and they will never perish, and no one will snatch them out of my hand" (John 10:27,28).

The world will do it's best to drown out the voice of Jesus (grace and truth – John 1:14) with either the sheer volume of untruths or by trying to scream the loudest! May God grant us with the wisdom and ability to be swift to hear and discern truth. If you listen to the right voice, you will make the right choice!
