Opportunities in Times of Distress

In II Corinthians chapter eleven Paul testified that on three occasions he was "beaten with rods." That was Roman punishment. The Jews used a leather whip. The Jews were limited by the law of how many lashes you could receive – but the Romans were not. The accused was often beaten to death by the Roman flogging.

We are privy to only one of these times that Paul was beaten by the Romans. (Acts 16:16-40) He and Silas were in the city of Philippi where they exorcised an evil spirit from a servant girl who was a fortune teller. Her masters dragged Paul and Silas into the city court. Surprisingly Paul did not inform the court that he was a Roman citizen and submitted to being beaten with rods. Luke records, "After they had laid upon them many wounds" they were sent to prison, put in the high-security cell and their feet were locked into wooden stocks.

Have you ever been punished for doing something good? What would be your response? I'm thinking ANGER! They weren't. Their clothes had been torn off. The entire assembly in the marketplace had attacked them. They had been publicly beaten with wooden rods. Their bodies were bleeding. They were put in stocks in the inner cell of the jail.

How did they react? – "About midnight Paul and Silas were praying and singing hymns to God . . . " What!!! I wonder what songs they were singing?

The rest of that verse says ". . . and the other prisoners were listening to them."

I see at least two takeaways here:

First - Being a Christian doesn't exempt us from trouble in this world. But we can handle any trouble because God has secured our future.

Second – Trouble/crises provide unique opportunities to influence those around us for the Lord.

Don't miss this opportunity.
