## **Don't Bite Your Fingernails**

I don't know about you, but I'm much more aware of coming in contact with something potentially contaminated than I have ever been before. I wash my hands much more frequently than I ever have. I have a box of disposable gloves and a mask. I carry a small dispenser of germ-killing hand sanitizer in my pocket. If I must go to the store, I make sure I wipe the shopping cart handle with sanitizing wipes, and I make an effort to practice "social distancing." I don't know if that phrase even existed before about a month ago.

Years ago, I made regular trips to Ghana, West Africa to teach in a preacher-training school. The first trip I made was on the tail-end of a severe drought. I had never seen anything like it. People had literally stripped bark off trees and boiled it for any nourishment it might provide. Disease accompanies drought. We brought our own food and boiled and strained our drinking water.

Besides my becoming much more appreciative and grateful for our living conditions when I returned home, there was another somewhat amusing serendipity for me personally – I had always had a habit of chewing my fingernails! But that trip made me extremely aware of everything I put in my mouth. Particularly my fingernails. I've never had a problem with biting my nails since!

I'm thinking, if we could become as aware of the harmful, deadly nature of sin, we would go to extreme measures to avoid contact with it. We might realize that we need to be very aware of what we watch on t.v., our speech, our companions, how we treat our family members, etc.
