### **Knowing What You Don't Know**

As people, we have a proclivity to seek independence. This is by no means an inherently bad quality, as we ought to be able to operate on our own, make decisions for ourselves, and ultimately be responsible for who we are. However, this independent nature often leads us to rely almost entirely on our own way of thinking to reason and make decisions. We focus heavily on teaching kids necessary critical thinking skills because it is important for us to learn how to think for ourselves and how to make our own decisions, and so because of this, hard sciences and math have become synonymous with ensuring that there is always an answer to the question and that we know what it is. Unfortunately, true science cannot operate under the principle that we always know the answer, as true science relies on one very key piece of information; what we do not know.

True understanding of a subject does not rely solely on what is known, but also must account for what is not known. Yet in our society today, the phrase, 'I don't know,' is seen as a sign of weakness. People seldom, if ever admit while in a conversation about a particular subject that they simply do not know the answers to questions others may ask. We would rather rely on our own knowledge and be wrong, than truthfully admit what we do not know. Scripture clearly tells us though the importance of knowing what we do not know.

Proverbs 3:5 says,

"Trust in the Lord with all your heart and do not lean on your own understanding."

The writer of Proverbs makes it clear that true wisdom and understanding comes from the realization that there are things we do not know and that there are times where we are not going to have all of the answers. We instead have to humbly rely on God to give us guidance, rather than seeking to do things our own way. While it is important for us to know things for ourselves and be able to reason and understand things, there is also an importance in admitting that we do not have all of the answers. We do, however, know who holds those answers, and while our minds may not be able to fully understand the Almighty God and His will, we can understand that His way is true, just, and right, and that it is in our best interest to put aside our pride and what we think we know, and admit what we do not know.
