For the last approximately ten years in our Community Bible Class we have been surveying the Bible. I have frequently said that it is my belief that you learn more about God from the Old Testament than you do from the New Testament.

We like one . . . the other, not so much.

So our age has chosen to ignore God's righteousness which demands that every sin be punished. Or as the Hebrews writer says "... every violation and disobedience received its just punishment" (2:2). Choosing to ignore God's righteousness, we have created a god that is only mercy and grace. We don't like "the god of the Old Testament" . . . so we dismiss him.

Paul admonishes the Christians in Rome to "... consider God's kindness and (his) severity." We must not make the mistake of dismissing either of God's characteristics.

Knowing God

As we worked our way through the Old Testament, we were faced with numerous incidences in which we struggled with God's actions. They seemed to us to be unnecessarily harsh or unfair. Think of Job or maybe Uzzah who was killed instantly because he touched the Ark of the Covenant. Think of God's instructions to utterly wipe out the inhabitants of Canaan. I often paused our study to ask the class - "Do you like God?"

It occurs to me that the Old Testament focuses on one characteristic of God and the New Testament focuses on another characteristic of God. God has two fundamental characteristics - righteousness and love. The characteristics are polar opposites. Righteousness demands justice; love pleads for mercy and grace.

In the last Old Testament book, Malachi, God says, "I the Lord do not change. . .."
