Masks ... or No Mask?

Since I have recently ventured into deep water with bulletin articles ("Do I Have to Buy the Whole Thing?" and "Was Jesus Woke?") ... and since there may be a few folks I have not yet offended, let me try one more time.

I seriously doubt, in the midst of this virus pandemic, if there is anyone who does not have a pretty definite opinion about wearing a mask. That's ok. You have a right to your opinion. So does everyone else.

This strikes me as a classic opportunity for us to apply the principles of Romans 14 which provides principles to enable us to maintain unity in God's family when we are facing differences of opinion.

The text uses two examples of differing opinions – whether or not it is acceptable to observe special days and if it is permissible to eat meat offered to idols. Both of these were creating division in the Lord's church.

Today's application - Must I wear a mask, or do I have the right to not wear a mask?

Because of severely-limited space, let me cut to the chase:

There are two principles involved in the biblical guidelines contained in this text.

First - How does this affect my relationship to the Lord? I dare say that both sides will answer, "It doesn't affect my relationship to the Lord." I agree.

But the second principle brings up another consideration – one that we tend to treat much less seriously – BUT GOD DOESN'T! How does [wearing a mask or not affect my relationship to my brothers and sisters?

As we are attempting to re-open our assemblies and Bible classes, we have been requested to wear a mask while we are transitioning to our seat and as we are transitioning from our seat to our cars. Lord willing, the day will come when this won't be an issue but currently we have families and individuals who will not attend while some refuse to wear a mask.

I hope you will take a few minutes to read and apply Romans 14. Let me stop with this quote - "Let us therefore make every effort to do what leads to peace and to mutual edification."

I hope you recognize and treasure the rare spirit of peace and unity we have here at WOCC. I pray that we love the Lord and one another enough to not allow something as temporary and insignificant as this to create any hint of division in God's family.

Please understand that I am not trying to make any decision for you. I'm asking that as you make your decision, that you consider not only your personal preferences but also the affect your decision has on others.

Woodland Oaks Brothers and Sisters,

Effective September 9, we will begin a soft restart of our Wednesday evening services. This will include time for songs and prayer, followed by a combined adult Bible class.
