#### ONE OF THE PREACHER'S "HATS"

One of the unique things about being a preacher is the position you are in - between the congregation and the eldership. Some view it as a curse; others, as a blessing.

Your position might be summarized by saying that you are a "middleman" or perhaps a "facilitator". You can, at least in some ways, represent the concerns and thoughts of the congregation to the elders and, on some occasions, you can represent the elders to the congregation. The advantage of this position is that if you are a peacemaker, you can often help avoid or clarify misunderstandings which otherwise could escalate into divisive issues.

One thing which can hinder your effectiveness in this role is if you do not have the confidence of both the elders and the congregation. That has to be earned. Effectiveness requires some level of objectivity. It also often requires that you be willing and able to effectively express things so that first impressions will be reconsidered. It must be evident that you love the Lord's church and that you genuinely care about everyone involved.

It's sad that some preachers are the product of teaching which instills an attitude of adversity against elders. They begin their ministry with an attitude "It's us against them." They follow the mantra, "It's easier to ask forgiveness than permission." They move a lot. Each time, they blame "bad elders." Interesting . . . how some preachers seem to have the bad luck of having to always deal with bad elders.

I don't mean to leave the impression that there are no elders who are poor shepherds. There are some. A few have personal agendas or unresolved problems which cause them to be ineffective or even destructive. There are a few preachers that way too. But both are the exception, not the norm.

I consider it a privilege to have the opportunity to be a peacemaker. Although, the "one in the middle often gets kicked by both sides", he also sometimes gets to feel the satisfaction of knowing that he helped avert a disaster. And much of the time, no one else knows it ... except his wife ... and God.
