Do I Have to Buy the Whole Thing?

Do you know what "bundling" is? Bundling is when somebody wants to sell you something that you don't want but it is beneficial to them that you have it – so they put it together with something they know you want and tell you that you have to buy the whole thing to get the part you want.

I'm going to step out onto some really dangerous ground right now.

Do black lives matter?

When I say, "Black lives matter", what does that mean? Does it mean that the life of an African American is as valuable and meaningful as the life of a Caucasian? Does it mean that a black person must be afforded every right and freedom that our constitution offers? Does it mean that he is to be treated as fully equal and no differently because of the color of his skin? If that is what it means, then every Christian must certainly want to wholeheartedly and enthusiastically say, "Yes! Black lives matter!"

But that's not all it means to everyone. It has been bundled!

There are some things that have been added into the Black Lives Matter Organization that you may not want. Somebody is using something you want to accomplish something you may not want!

Here are a couple of quotes from the website <u>blacklivesmatter.com</u>:

"What We Believe: We disrupt the Western-prescribed nuclear family structure requirement by supporting each other as extended families and "villages" that collectively care for one another, especially our children, to the degree that mothers, parents, and children are comfortable."

"We foster a queer-affirming network. When we gather, we do so with the intention of freeing ourselves from the tight grip of heteronormative thinking, or rather, the belief that all in the world are heterosexual (unless s/he or they disclose otherwise)."

So, while I gladly stand shoulder-to-shoulder with my black brothers and sisters against every form of racial prejudice and injustice, I also firmly stand against the characterization of moral principles as being "western-prescribed" rather than "biblically-prescribed".

Don't allow yourself to be forced into supporting something that is wrong in order to support something that is right. You don't have to accept the bundling in order to do what is right. We stand against wrong just as firmly as we stand for right.
