God Loves Justice

My daily Bible reading is currently in Deuteronomy. Deuteronomy is basically the CliffsNotes of the history of Israel's deliverance from Egyptian slavery up to the preparation to enter Canaan. Moses writes it – from his (and God's) perspective.

It occurred to me that if I ever have the opportunity to teach Old Testament history again, when I get to the beginning of Exodus, I will stop there and go to the first eleven chapters of Deuteronomy to get a skeleton outline of the next 40 years and then return to Exodus to put the meat on that skeleton.

Moses reveals some details in Deuteronomy that we didn't have access to in reading Exodus, Leviticus and Numbers.

Here's a practical lesson I picked up in Deuteronomy:

If you know very much about God, you know that justice is important to him. Basically, justice means doing the right, fair thing to others.

I was reading in Deut. 1:15 where God instructed Moses to appoint judges to settle disputes fairly. He says that these judges are to be guided by two principles: first, "... do not show partiality ..." and second, "Do not be afraid of any man." It occurred to me that those are two principles that guard against justice being perverted. I noted that in the margin of my Bible. Then, a couple of days later, I ran across a third principle to add to that list – Deut. 10:17 – (speaking of God) – "... who shows no partiality and accepts no bribes."

These three principles are characteristics of God. They are to be guiding principles of every court system and they are to be characteristic of every Christian. Truth, justice and righteousness depend on it.

Do not let your judgements in matters great or small be perverted by partiality in any form, by fear of negative consequences or by the hope of personal gain.

Psalms 11:7 "For the Lord is righteous, he loves justice; the upright will see his face."
