The Risk of Faith

The purpose of faith is to motivate us to take risks. To understand faith is to realize that it challenges us to commit to things beyond the ability of our own resources. To live by faith is to step out into a realm in which failure is certain if God doesn't act.

It is a call to load up your sling and face a giant who wants to kill you. To step out of the boat and walk to Jesus. To give the last of your money. To send your child to a mission field . . . with your blessing. To go yourself. To talk to your neighbor about Jesus.

There is a risk involved everywhere you see faith. To live without risk is to live without faith. To bury your talents rather than using them is to live without faith. To allow your physical concerns and desires to supersede your desire to please Him is to live without faith.

Faith demands that you step outside your comfort zone. It demands that you refuse to be controlled by your fears.

Walking by faith requires two things: First, we must want to respond to Jesus' call "Come follow me." Some don't . . . because we don't like where he's going. Second, we have to believe that we won't be going alone. We have to believe that he won't abandon us when we get out there.

The call of faith is like your conscience- if you ignore it, or say "No" long enough, it won't bother you any longer. His voice will grow so weak we won't hear it any longer.

Refusing to follow is not an option for a disciple. ". . . everything that does not come from faith is sin."
