How to be an Influencer

I've been hearing this unfamiliar term for some time so I figured I'd find out what it means. The term is **influencer**. They say that forty-five percent of the world's population actively uses social media on the internet – almost 3.5 billion people.

An influencer is exactly what you would expect the term to mean - someone who has developed a following of people on an internet medium (Twitter, Facebook, etc.) who look to them for advice for decision-making. The areas of influence are unlimited. It can range from advice about the best goods and services available to political advice. Influencers are generally rated according to the number of "followers" they have on their website. A mega-influencer has more than one million followers on at least one platform; a nano-influencer has fewer than one thousand.

Companies and organizations are very aware of the influence that these persons can have and are becoming increasingly willing to pay for recommendations on sites which effectively influence their target audience.

It seems to me that we Christians should focus on being an influencer. If so, how would we go about qualifying? Here's what I'm thinking:

First – Be a person who can be respected

- People who respect you will be attracted to you.

Second – Truly care about others

- Notice positive efforts in others and acknowledge it with encouraging words or notes.

Third – Be available

- You don't have to have answers to every problem but we can visit the hospital; we can pray with those who are struggling.

You can be in influencer. God will notice . . . and he will reward you.
