THE LAW AND THE GOSPEL

"All things are permissible – but not everything is constructive." I Corinthians 10:23.

Freedom is a wonderful thing. ("All things are permissible . . . ") if it is exercised within proper boundaries (... not everything is constructive.)

My problem is - I'm not sure I can trust you with it. In fact, I'm pretty sure I can't. And since I can't trust you, I've got to limit your freedom with some laws. But every time I pass a law, you find a loophole. So I've got to pass some more laws.

That's what laws do - limit freedom. They define the boundaries. They discipline people who won't discipline themselves. "We also know that law is not made for good men, but for lawbreakers and rebels, the ungodly and sinful, the unholy and irreligious . . . " I Tim 1:9.

Laws are necessary for society to exist. Because there are so many who refuse to discipline themselves, others must enforce discipline on them.

But law can only do so much - (Romans 8:3 "what the law was powerless to do ..."). What is law powerless to do? Well . . . among other things, it cannot change a man's heart.

As Christians, let's be reminded that men are not going to be saved by passing the right laws. God ordained government and we have to have laws. But lest we forget, God sent us to preach the gospel as the only real answer to our problems. Let's not get sidetracked.
