#### You Choose

What things shape our lives? What are the strongest influences that determine what kind of person we will be?

Likely most adults can reflect on our early life and pinpoint someone who had a profound effect on decisions we made that shaped our present life. Some of those influencers are obvious – our parents. For those who are fortunate to have had godly, loving parents, we followed their teaching and training; for others, the lack of parenting or dysfunctional parenting shaped our lives as you determined to not follow their example. Their negative influenced your decisions as surely as those who had parents who were a positive influence.

Other influencers may have included a teacher(s) or friends or someone who took an interest in you – maybe a coach.

But I can choose friends who are Christians. I can choose to attend every Bible class and assembly and bring my family. I can choose to make a practice of reading my Bible every day. I can choose to listen to music that reflects moral values . . . or I can choose not to.

You ultimately choose who and what influences your life. Are your choices bringing you closer to God?
