## **My Political Party**

**My political party:** I absolutely despise all the stuff that's going on now. Satan is having a heyday! My political party? Same as Paul's (Philippians 3:20) - the Heavenly Party! That's what he says. "... our citizenship is in heaven." The Greek word for citizenship is politeuo - the root for our word politics. We are governed from heaven. God is our ruler. His word is our law. It's what guides us. Peter told the Sanhedrin court "We must obey God rather than men!"

Because of my political party, I feel a deep responsibility to address moral issues. I will not be intimidated into silence. Moving a moral issue into the political arena does not make it off limits. Neither does claiming that social issues are spiritual issues make it so. I feel no particular allegiance to any earthly political party. I cannot think of one thing I do or think because of my earthly political affiliation. I will not be pressured into defending anything or anyone against my beliefs.

It's easy to substitute physical matters for spiritual matters.

I have long observed that it is far easier to motivate people about physical things than it is to motivate them about spiritual matters. Even many Christians! Paul addressed that contrast in I Timothy 4:8 where he is advising Timothy about focusing on things that are really profitable and not becoming sidetracked by things that are relatively unimportant: "For physical training profits a little, but godliness is profitable for everything, holding promise for both the present life and the life to come."

As Christians, we have a responsibility to be committed to things beyond the concern for this life. If we "become involved in civilian affairs" we become incapable of "pleasing our commanding officer." (see II Timothy 2:4).

People are dying without Jesus as their Redeemer. That's the real tragedy. That's our mission. That's our politics. Focus on it. Don't let the concerns of this life sidetrack you.

Are you familiar with the song "Turn Your Eyes Upon Jesus?" It says, "Turn your eyes upon Jesus, Look full in his wonderful face, And the things of earth will grow strangely dim, in the light of his glory and arace."
