Who's at the Door?

At a really crucial time in Cain's life, God spoke to him and said, "If you do well, will you not be accepted? And if you do not do well, sin is crouching at the door. Its desire is for you, but you must rule over it."

His brother's sacrifice had been accepted by God and his own had been rejected. He was angry and he was jealous. God knew exactly what was in his heart. So God said to him, "Cain, you've made a bad choice and you're about to make another choice. You can make a good, wise choice and everything will be fine. But if you act on what you're feeling, you are going to be controlled and consumed by your sin. Choose wisely."

He didn't listen and his life (as well as his descendants' lives) was set on a destructive course.

Sin is that way. Once you open the door, it comes in and takes control. It doesn't even matter WHY you opened the door. Maybe it was because you were angry, or tempted, or curious. It doesn't matter. The only thing that matters is that you allowed it to come in. Once in, you no longer have control of your own life.

Many years later, the apostle Paul will write about our liberty as Christians. He will say, "Everything is permissible to me (I can make any choice I want)- but I will not be mastered by (brought under the power of/controlled by) anything."

Same scene. You have choices to make. Choose wisely, everything will be fine. Open the door to sin and you just surrendered control of your life! Your sin will control your life from now on.

Every one of us is faced with this same scenario. Sin is crouching at the door. It desires to come in. Don't open the door! He can't come in unless you invite him in. Once in, he won't leave. He's in control.

The only voice he will obey now is Jesus'. You can't make him leave . . . but Jesus can. He is standing at the door of your heart knocking. Won't you let him come in?
