“I Can’t” Really Means “I Don’t Want To”

When my dad and mom moved to Ferriday, LA as newlyweds, there was no church of Christ there. His training was in electrical engineering. He was recently discharged from the Army, went to college on the G.I. Bill, got married and moved to an area where he had never lived.

He tried to locate a preacher to help start a church. He enlisted the aid of everyone he thought might be able to help. No one could be found. After months of constant effort that exhausted everyone’s patience, the preacher who had tried to help, said, “You’re going to have to do it!” His response was, “I can’t.” . . . But he did.

Consequently, I was never allowed to say, “I can’t.” There were many times that I felt he required of me much more than I was capable of doing. But I had no choice; I had to try. And . . . honestly, I failed a lot. But even then, “I can’t” still didn’t get me off the hook. So I did my best.

And I learned some things: “I can’t” usually means “I don’t want to.” “I can’t” is often rooted in fear. Fear is not an acceptable excuse with God (nor my dad).

I also learned that I’m not “the best” at anything; but “not being the best” is not the same as failure. And, when you try (even if you didn’t want to) . . . you often find some hidden talents.

. . . Maybe this is some of what the Lord meant when he concluded his Parable of the Talents with, *“Take the talent from him [one-talent man who was afraid to use it] and give it to the one who has ten talents. For everyone who has will be given more, and he will have an abundance. Whoever does not have, even what he has will be taken from him.”* - Matthew 25:28-29.
