Leading a Quiet Life

Like you, I am seeing, reading and hearing a constant barrage of anger and criticism about events occurring in our world and in our country. Everyone seems to have a cupful of gasoline to throw on the fire. The devil is the master manipulator. He's been around for quite a while. He knows exactly how to push our buttons. Anger is one of his most effective tools. We often do and say wrong things when we are

"In your anger do not sin' a: Do not let the sun go down while you are still angry, and do not give the devil a foothold." - Ephesians 4:26-27. We need to calm down or we could lose our soul trying to gain the world. The phrase "In your anger do not sin..." Paul lifted from Psalm 4. I encourage you to listen to the verses before and after it in that context: "Know that the Lord has set apart the godly for himself; the Lord will hear when I call to him. In your anger [literally- "to quiver with emotion"] do not sin; when you are on your beds search your hearts and be silent. Offer right sacrifices and trust in the *Lord.*" – vs. 3-5

What are we to do when the news causes us to start "quivering with emotion?" Well... first of all we need to watch less news. Seriously! Quit fanning the flames! Then, "Make it your ambition to lead a quiet life, to mind your own business and to work with your hands...." - I Thess. 4:11. Do something productive. And take it to the Lord in prayer. "I urge, then, first of all, that requests, prayers, intercession and thanksgiving be made for everyone- for kings and all those in authority, that we may live peaceful and quiet lives in all godliness and holiness. This is good, and pleases God our *Savior*." – I Tim. 2:1-3

If we want to do something more than criticize, let's take our concerns to someone who can actually do something about the situation! I wish I knew where the following suggestion originated, but I don't. But I want to encourage each one of us to do the following:

Someone has said that if Christians really understood the full extent of the power we have available through prayer, we might be speechless. Did you know that during World War II there was an advisor to Churchill who organized a group of people who dropped what they were doing every day at the prescribed hour for **one minute** to collectively pray for the safety of England its people and peace?

There is now a group of people organizing the same thing here in America. If you

Every evening at 8 p.m. Central, stop what you are doing and spend one minute praying for the safety of the Unites States, our troops, our citizens, and for a return to a Godly nation. If you have a smart phone – set an alarm to pray from 8-8:01 p.m. Please pass this along to your prayerful family and friends. Our prayers are the most powerful asset we have.

Let's stop allowing the devil to use us and let's let the Lord use us.
