#### Criticism

There are not very many things in the world that I can't criticize. I have to watch that about myself. My wife reminds me of that fact occasionally! But the truth is I'm a pretty good critic. Better than most . . . even if I say so myself . . . So think we all.

There is much to be said about criticism. Pro and con. Mostly con. It's fascinating to me because it has such utility. It serves so many self-serving purposes.

It is a cheap way to feel superior. You don't have to do one single thing. No effort, no expense. Just take your shot and walk away a winner! Sounds like a carney hawk, doesn't it? Come to think of it, that kind of describes it. Attracts attention to yourself but others soon realize that it's empty . . . That is, everybody but you [realizes it].

It easily becomes a substitute for "doing". Critics almost never accomplish anything. They don't build things. Have you noticed that? They are satisfied when they dumped their load of criticism on you. Feel no need to do anything more. They accomplished their purpose. They kept you from doing anything that would make them appear inferior.

It is a means of controlling others. That's exactly what Jesus is teaching in Matthew 11:16-19 in his story about the children in the marketplace. Let me tell you a little secret about people who criticize for manipulation: They won't be happy when they get what they appear to want, because what they really want is to control you. And that never ends.

Criticism is a handy little tool. Some folks are pros at using it. Of all the things that the church needs, it doesn't need more critics.
