This doesn't mean that every person who is rich, educated or religious is arrogant. Some of the most humble people I know are all three. However, the Bible does warn about trusting in any of the above.

But there is another danger regarding these matters which is largely ignored- there is the very real danger of "reverse pride". Believe it or not, one can be just as arrogant about being poor as he can about being rich . . . or being uneducated as being educated . . . or being immoral as being "righteous".

In the end, is there any real difference between being proud of being "redneck" than being proud of being "metro?" . . . Depends on which crowd you run with, doesn't it? And if you don't know that there can be proud fraternity in being poor, then you never were poor. There is as much arrogance on one side of the tracks as the other.

If you've not noticed that there can be arrogance among the immoral, you've been living in a different world. In fact, we are living in a time when the most immoral among us seem to be the most arrogant.

As with everything else, it's not new. "The look on their faces testifies against them; they parade their sin like Sodom; they do not hide it. Woe to them! They have brought disaster against themselves." - Isaiah 3:9.
