Knowing When to Fold 'Em

Some years ago, a preacher friend came to me for advice about the situation in which he found himself. He had invested several years of his life in a congregation that was experiencing solid growth. The church was nearing the need for additional space and building plans were being considered.

The problem was that one of his elders, a former preacher for that congregation, had obviously decided that he wanted to return to the pulpit of this church. The pressure began subtly but had increased over time to the point that my friend was informed that he would be required to submit to the elders a written copy of his sermons the week before they were to be delivered.

My friend came to visit with me. He didn't like my advice. I advised him to graciously leave. He was adamant. He had spent several years of his life investing his full efforts into this congregation and it wasn't fair that he was being "forced out". I understood his feelings. I still advised him to leave. My reasoning was this - "You have spent X-number of years helping to build this church. Your choice right now is – are you going to allow it to be destroyed by gathering your loyal friends around you and fighting this personal injustice? You cannot win. If you 'win', you lose . . . and more importantly, the church loses. ARE YOU MORE IMPORTANT THAN THE UNITY OF THIS CHURCH?"

He chose to stay and fight. On the bloody morning after . . . the unity of the church was destroyed. Many of his friends were so angry they left the church. In the process, he became so bitter that he left, not only the church and preaching, but he abandoned his wife and children as well. He was willing for the church to suffer in order to vindicate himself. And it did! . . . and it still is!

While I certainly sympathized with his feelings, he put his own welfare, pride and personal agenda before the welfare of the church. Unfortunately, I've seen this type of thing happen numerous times. Paul asked the Corinthian Christians, "Why not rather be wronged? Why not rather be cheated? (rather than press your dispute to court?)."

Are my rights or my freedoms or my pride more important than the unity and welfare of the Lord's body?
