He and Silas entered Philippi. Soon after, they were stripped, severely beaten and put in wooden stocks in the high-security section of prison. Following their release the next day, they went to Thessalonica (approx. 100 mi). They were run out of town by a mob of jealous Jews who followed them to Berea and drove Paul out of town again. He traveled to Athens to wait for his companions to join him. Paul sent Timothy back to check on the new Christians in Thessalonica. When Timothy joins him in Athens, Paul writes a letter of encouragement to them (First

In the conclusion of that letter he lists a series of things upon which they are to focus. Here's a partial list - "Live in peace with each other. . . encourage the timid, help the weak, be patient with everyone... always be kind to each other and everyone else. Be joyful always; pray continually; give thanks in all circumstances, for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus. . . Hold on to the good. Avoid every

It occurs to me that if I would begin with the first item on that list (there are additional items in chapter 5) and focus on that for a full day and do the same regarding the second charge on the next day, etc. I think that would really please the Lord, and it would make me a better person.

Let's use this time that we have wisely - to improve ourselves and encourage others.
