Build a Christian Dynasty

A beaver and a chipmunk happened upon the Hoover Dam while out strolling one day. They were caught off-guard, completely overwhelmed with amazement and awe at the size and magnificence of the structure. Once the beaver recovered, he remarked, "Well, actually, I didn't build it myself, but it's based upon an idea of mine."

One of the best compliments I've ever received came from one of my daughters recently. She had returned from a trip she had made for the purpose of assisting people during a difficult time. I told her how proud I was of her and she responded, "I got it from you."

As I think back on my life, I realize more than ever that I was given a solid foundation for building a Christian life. My parents were exceptionally dedicated to the Lord and his church. I realize that much of both my desire and whatever ability I have is due to what they taught me and how they lived.

Priority is everything. You can't disguise priority. It is reflected in what you talk about, how you spend your time, how you spend your money, how you treat others . . . it's reflected in everything. We pass those priorities on to our children. That's where they start. They either build on those priorities or they evaluate them and decide to reject them.

Our challenge as parents and grandparents is to match our words up with our life. Consistency . . . it's crucial. It reflects your true priority. "Do what I say and not what I do" never did work. It's the Hypocrite's Creed.

Don't expect spiritual matters to be the priority of your child's life if it's not yours. Telling your child how important the Lord is and then allowing other activities to cause you to be inconsistent in your commitment to the Lord will likely result in their rejection of what you say in favor of what you do.

When I think of what I want my family and friends to be able to say about me, it is "He practiced what he preached." They can build their lives on that idea.
