What Time Is It?

Everyone loves short, pithy phrases which state a general truth principle. The grammar term is *aphorism*.

It's fun to have a list of such statements and have a group discussion of their meaning and application. An old aphorism says, "The chickens always come home to roost." How many situations illustrate the truthfulness of that one? I suppose there are hundreds of such sayings.

The beauty of these statements is that they are short, easy to remember and applicable to so many experiences in life. The shortcoming is that they are not absolute. The message may apply to the majority of situations but there are exceptions.

Most of you are somewhat familiar with the Tulsa Soul-Winning Workshop. It began in 1976 and continued through 2016. I attended the first years of its beginning. The phrase that permeated those early years was "What God Controls Grows!" Catchy huh? And I'm confident that it served the good purpose of encouraging evangelism

But, as biblical as that sounds, it's not an absolute. I'm thinking of Noah. I'm thinking of the fig tree that died because of Jesus' curse. I'm thinking of those persecuted Christians mentioned in Hebrews 11 who "... wandered in deserts and mountains, and in caves and holes in the ground." If everything God controls grows, were they failures?

I'm not belittling motivational mottos. I like many of them. But we need to think through them. Don't elevate them to the level of scripture – regardless of how good they sound.

Biblical wisdom says, "There is a time to plant and a time to uproot, . . . a time to build and a time to tear down, . . . a time for war and a time for peace." – Eccl. 3

Let's ask God for wisdom to know what time it is.
