United We Stand

While I was at Harding I had the privilege of attending several classes on congregational ministry, church growth, and church conflict. While many of the other Bible majors were focused on biblical history, language, and theory, I would spend my time delving into the numbers and factors that would make a church tick. Whether it was the fact that it was a relatively unexplored area of study as compared to my peers, or because I am simply a "numbers guy", these fields greatly interested me. I found myself spending hours familiarizing myself with the numbers and statistics of churches that would grow, as well as churches that would split. Many people would say you can't simplify what grows or splits a church into numbers, and that is certainly true, and finding the truth about growing churches is usually as easy as asking their members. I am not just referring to churches which are growing numerically, but in a greater sense of depth in their relationship with God. When something works, it is often very apparent, and in every case with Christians, true growth comes by adhering to specific biblical truths and principles. It's easy to see what makes a church grow, the challenge often comes from understanding why churches decline and split.

It's in these situations that one cannot simply get a straight answer. Everyone has their own opinion about why things don't work, and it is often difficult to ask those who are not around anymore why it is that they left. All we are left with is to look for the common denominators between churches who have seen splits and declines.

In my quest for a greater understanding of these things, I found myself, as a student at Harding, sitting at a dining table at Harding Place, having a long and memorable conversation with the late Flavil Yeakley, one of the greatest statisticians on congregational growth in our brotherhood. Aside from speaking on research methodology, Dr. Yeakley also mentioned something that stuck with me. He stressed to me that there was a reason Paul spent so much of his time warning against division. He told me that he had been to so many congregations which could have avoided serious turmoil if they had simply prioritized unity over personal opinion. Everyone feels that their issue is doctrinal, but few consider that there is nothing doctrinal about causing strife among believers.

To find the common denominator in failing churches, one simply needs to look at the atmosphere which has been bred there. No congregation can sew both unity and division, and yet our fellowship's call to the former seems overshadowed by desire for the latter. We are blessed in our congregation to enjoy an atmosphere of unity, but Paul warns that we must always be alert to those who would seek to cause conflict.

In Romans 16:17 Paul states, "I urge you, brothers and sisters, to watch out for those who cause divisions and put obstacles in your way that are contrary to the teaching you have learned. Keep away from them."

Let us continue to seek unity, and not lose sight of it as it is both Christ's calling and prayer for us. There is no reason to focus on another's error, when it is for our own errors that we require the same grace of Christ which has been extended to all. We are in a time of great division in our country, and while it may be easy to fall into the same divisive mindset that has become so pervasive, it is not fitting to our identity in Christ. This is our opportunity to show an example of true unity to a divided world.
