In the Midst of the Storm

Matthew records two incidences of Jesus' demonstration of his power over stormy seas – chapter 8 and chapter 14 (also recorded in Mark 4 & Luke 8; Mark 6 & John 6).

The Sea of Galilee is approximately thirteen miles long, eight miles wide and one hundred forty feet deep (deepest point).

Two storms. The disciples learned something from that first storm. Even though Jesus was [literally] peacefully sleeping while the waves were so fierce that the boat was being swamped . . . at least he was in the boat. So they learned that "if Jesus is in your boat, everything is going to be OK."

But the second time they got into trouble on the lake, it was dark and Jesus wasn't in the boat! They had been rowing against the wind for hours and they were in the middle of the lake (3-4 miles from shore) – in the deepest part. Mark says that "He saw the disciples straining at the oars" - even though Jesus was in the hills praying, even though it was in the early, pre-dawn hours and even though it was storming.

I suspect these men were voicing their wish "If only Jesus were here with us, we wouldn't be afraid!" Then he appeared – walking on the water. He knew where they were and what was happening to them. Both times he chastised them for their fear and their lack of faith.

Jesus knows where you are and he knows what's happening. He knows what's happening in the world, what's happening in our country and what's happening to you personally. If we are not absolutely confident of this and if we doubt his ability or his love, we live in fear and anger. But if we truly trust him, we can sleep peacefully. . . even in the midst of the storm.
