Sweetening Bitter Water

I don't get out of sorts too often. Or at least I like to think I don't, but I'm out of sorts today. It seems like everything and everyone is trying to push me backwards. I won't bore you with the details because I might find out that you have worse problems than me, and that would really ruin my day.

And right in the middle of me enjoying my mad, a friend sent me an article that evidently God wanted me to read. Here's an excerpt: "Then Moses ordered Israel to set out from the Red Sea and they went into the wilderness of Shur. They went three days in the wilderness and found no water. When they came to Marah, they could not drink the water of Marah because it was bitter. That is why it was called Marah. And the people complained against Moses saying, 'What shall we drink?' He cried out to the Lord; and the Lord showed him a piece of wood; he threw it into the water, and the water became sweet" (Exodus 15:22-25).

"... we are on a spiritual journey out of the bondage of Egypt, through the wilderness, and into the Promised Land of our destiny. And along the way we can grow weary and worn.
