Hijacking the Gospel

Four airplanes were hijacked. Two thousand nine hundred and ninety six people died at the Twin Towers in New York City, the Pentagon in Arlington, VA and in a field near Shanskville, PA.

I don't want anything like that to ever happen again, do you? How can we keep this from ever happening again? Do we make a law that bans airplanes? That would do it, wouldn't it? ... Maybe... But probably not!

We take every reasonable precaution to try to ensure that it doesn't happen again. If you've flown anywhere within the last ten years, you're familiar with some of these efforts. But we all live with the realization that it could possibly happen again in spite of our best efforts.

In an even more serious arena, some folks have hijacked the gospel- the incredible truth that "God's righteousness is available by grace through faith apart from works of law." They *abuse* God's grace. They treat it as if it gives license to sin. They teach an "easy-believism" that if you simply acknowledge that Jesus is Lord, you are irrevocably saved.

How can we keep this from happening? Do we quit teaching/preaching the gospel? That would do it, wouldn't it? ... Maybe... But probably not!

We take every reasonable precaution to try to ensure that it doesn't happen. We teach about the dangers involved, we warn, we try to persuade, but **we do not quit preaching the gospel.**

"I am not ashamed of the gospel, because it is the power of God for the salvation of everyone who believes: first for the Jew, then for the Gentile. For in the gospel a righteousness from God is revealed, a righteousness that is by faith from first to last, just as it is written: "The righteous will live by faith." - Romans 1:16-17.
