# **Benefits Of Reading Your Bible**

I've never been an avid reader. Everyone else in my family is a voracious reader. My wife and kids can read a book in 48 hours that would take me 48 days (or more) to read. Whether you are a slow reader or a fast reader there are some extraordinary benefits to reading. Reading books can reduce mortality by 20%. Reading helps lessen cognitive decline. Reading reduces stress. Reading also improves critical thinking. These are just a few benefits of reading. If this is true of reading book written by men and women, imagine the benefits of reading a book written by God. Here are a few benefits of reading the Bible in addition to what is mentioned above.

- 1. The Bible produces faith (Rom. 10:17).
- 2. The Bible reveals God's character. It is our definitive source for the answers to our questions about God (Ex. 34:6,7; Col. 1:15-20; Heb. 1:1-4).
- 3. The Bible teaches us to imitate God (Eph. 5:1).
- 4. The Bible reveals to us what true love is (John 3:16; 1 John 4:7,8).
- 5. The Bible keeps us from sin (Ph. 119:11).
- 6. The Bible is God's absolute truth (John 17:17).
- 7. The Bible reveals the good news of Jesus to us (Mark 1:1; 1 Cor. 15:1-4).
- 8. The Bible tells us what Jesus did to offer us salvation (Phil. 2:1-11).
- 9. The Bible teaches us salvation is found ONLY in Jesus (Acts 4:12).
- 10. The Bible helps us see our true selves (James 1:19-25).
- 11. The Bible warns us of sin and its effects (James 1:13-16).
- 12. The Bible nourishes us and helps us grow spiritually (2 Pet. 2:2; Matt. 4:4).
- 13. The Bible helps us make godly decisions (Ps. 119:105).
- 14. The Bible equips us to defeat the devil (Eph. 6:10-17).
- 15. The Bible is perpetually relevant (Heb. 4:12).

The Bible is God's way of speaking directly to us (2 Tim. 3:16) and so we read it to apply it to ourselves first and foremost (2 Tim. 2:15). The more we read the Bible for the purpose of internalizing it and allowing it to condition our hearts and minds, the more we will be transformed to be like Jesus. That's the primary goal of Christians. We want to be like Jesus. Be sure to spend time this week reading your Bible!
