Encourage One Another

"Take care, brothers, lest there be in any of you an evil, unbelieving heart, leading you to fall away from the living God. But exhort one another every day, as long as it is called "today," that none of you may be hardened by the deceitfulness of sin" (Hebrews 3:12,13).

In Chapter 3:6-8, the writer tells them to "hold fast their confidence" (v6), to "hear his voice" (v7), and "do not harden your *hearts*" (v8). In verse 12, the writer says "take care, brothers" which means "look at yourself" or "be discerning of yourself." These Jewish Christians needed to take a good discerning look at their heart because they were in real danger of developing an "evil unbelieving heart, leading them to fall away from the living God" (3:12). The antidote to prevent an unbelieving heart is daily encouragement (v13). The writer tells them to encourage one another daily. The word translated "encourage" gives the idea of an up-close personal interaction with each other. This kind of personal and spiritual encouragement is extremely powerful. The writer says this kind of encouragement can prevent or reverse a heart hardened by sin (v13).

Here are some appropriate times to encourage a member of your

• Encourage someone when you notice they aren't in Bible class.

• Encourage someone when notice they missed one of our worship

• Encourage someone when you realize you haven't seen them at a Church function in a while.

Here are some ideas of how to encourage a member of your Church

• Express your concern and listen.

• Pray with them.

• Share a Bible verse.

• Share with them how you have witnessed God at work in your life


