A Key To Happiness

I'm reading and listening through the Old Testament and it is striking to read all the horrible offenses that God's people committed against God. God called the nation of Israel, out of slavery and into freedom and gave them His law. The purpose of calling them out of bondage to freedom was so they could be a light to the nations through holy living. Time and again they failed. They built and worshipped idols, indulged in sexual immorality, and sacrificed their children to false gods. Their failure to live as holy people wasn't a one-time incident. There was approximately a 400-year span (Judges) where God's people did what was right in their own eyes without any thought of God. EPIC FAIL!!! The list of Israel's failures would make us blush, and when held up to our own lives, it makes us feel pretty good about ourselves. Be aware of self-righteousness.

But God is "a God merciful and gracious, slow to anger, and abounding in steadfast love and faithfulness, keeping steadfast love for thousands, forgiving iniquity and transgression and sin, but who will by no means clear the guilty, visiting the iniquity of the fathers on the children and the children's children, to the third and the fourth generation" (Ex. 34:6,7). God was patient. He loved them, pursued them, disciplined them, and forgave them when they turned to Him in repentance.

In the New Testament, we see the same picture. God called the Jews and Gentiles out of the world through obedience to the gospel of Jesus Christ to be a light to the world through holy living. We've been called out of darkness and into God's marvelous light. In the New Testament, we read about Christians who lied to God, were sexual immoral, and got drunk observing the Lord's Supper. Even today, there are Christians who are rebellious and unfaithful to God. WE FAIL EPICALLY!!!

Although God is patient with us, don't confuse His patience with tolerance, approval, or ignoring our sin. God cannot ignore or look the other way when dealing with sin. Read Psalm 5:4-6. God's wrath doesn't discriminate against sin, but the good news is, neither does the blood of Jesus.

"Or do you not know that the unrighteous will not inherit the kingdom of God? Do not be deceived: neither the sexually immoral, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor men who practice homosexuality, nor thieves, nor the greedy, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor swindlers will inherit the kingdom of God. And such were some of you. But you were washed, you were sanctified, you were justified in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ and by the Spirit of our God" (1 Cor. 6:9-11).
