The Resurrection of Jesus

In his opening remarks to the Church at Rome, Paul said, "Paul, a servant of Christ Jesus, called to be an apostle, set apart for the gospel of God, ²which he promised beforehand through his prophets in the holy Scriptures, ³concerning his Son, who was descended from David according to the flesh ⁴and was declared to be the Son of God in power according to the Spirit of holiness by his resurrection from the dead, Jesus Christ our Lord, ⁵through whom we have received grace and apostleship to bring about the obedience of faith for the sake of his name among all the nations, ⁶including you who are called to belong to Jesus Christ, ⁷To all those in Rome who are loved by God and called to be saints: Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ" (Romans 1:1-7).

Paul emphatically says Jesus' resurrection from the dead declares He is the Son of God! The resurrection of Jesus is one of the foundational elements of the gospel. Without the resurrection of Jesus from the dead, Christianity falls into a million little pieces. Paul discusses the resurrection at length in 1 Corinthians 15 and mentions the importance. Some in the Church at Corinth didn't believe in the bodily resurrection to come. Here's what Paul had to say.

- If there is no resurrection of the dead, then not even Christ has been raised (v13).
- If Christ has not been raised, then our preaching is in vain, and your faith is in vain (v14).
- If Christ has not been raised, your faith is futile, and you are still in your sins (v17).
- If Christ has not been raised, those also who have fallen asleep in Christ have perished (v18).
- If Christ has not been raised, we are of all people most to be pitied (v19).

"But in fact, Christ has been raised from the dead, the first fruits of those who have fallen asleep. For as by a man came death, by a man has come also the resurrection of the dead. For as in Adam all die, so also in Christ shall all be made alive. But each in his own order: Christ the first fruits, then at his coming those who belong to Christ. Then comes the end, when he delivers the kingdom to God the Father after destroying every rule and every authority and power" (1 Corinthians 15:20-24).

If Jesus is not resurrected, then our hope to be resurrected to an imperishable and immortal body to eternal life is dead. "But thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ" (1 Cor. 15:57).
